		The trade balance is calculated by deducting imports from exports.
		Total, Business cycle total (total 1) and General total (total 2)
		The results of the foreign trade statistics are published according to the Business cycle total (total 1) and the General total (total 2). The totals vary in so far that precious metals and gemstones, as well as works of art and antiques, are included in total 2, but not

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		in total 1. Total 1 is mainly used for economic considerations, while total 2 is preferably used for comparisons with other countries.
		Broad economic categories
		The register of broad economic categories groups individual goods according to their common usage. It is based on a Swiss nomenclature which encompasses 6 main groups.
		Nature of goods
		The register of the nature of goods comprises the foreign trade results according to economic sectors. It is based on a Swiss nomenclature which encompasses 14 main groups.
5	Statistical unit	CHF and tonnes are used as statistical units.
6	Statistical popula- tion	The statistical population consists of Liechtenstein's cross-border trade in goods with foreign countries except with and via Switzerland.

9	Note	Trade in goods with Switzerland:
		The trade in goods is recorded by the Federal Customs Administration at the Swiss borders and taken over by the Office of Statistics for Liechtenstein. The trade in goods with and via Switzerland is not included in the present tables.
		Trade in goods via Switzerland:
		Based on the postcode in the recipient's address (imports) or the sender's address (exports), the Federal Customs Administration makes an evaluation of the trade according to the individual cantons and the Principality of Liechtenstein. However, since the goods' place of receipt or dispatch does not have to match the goods' point of sale or place of production, the validity of this evaluation is limited.
		Trade in services:
		The information in the present tables is related to the trade in goods. For this reason, the trade in services is not included.
