Natural gas, electricity, heating oil and petrol are amongst the major energy sources in Liechtenstein, which is strongly dependent upon energy imports. The proportion of own energy supply to total energy consumption is 8%. Liechtenstein's energy production is limited to the energy sources electricity, firewood and biogas.

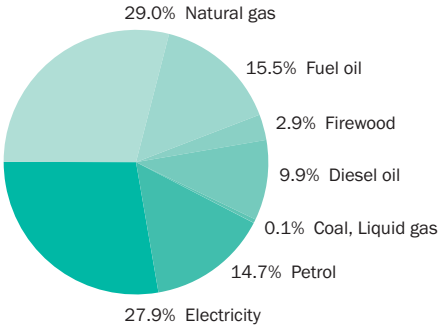
