Verordnung

vom 28. Juni 2010

**betreffend die Abänderung der Verordnung
über Massnahmen gegenüber der Islamischen
Republik Iran**

Aufgrund von Art. 2 des Gesetzes vom 10. Dezember 2008 über die Durchsetzung internationaler Sanktionen (ISG), LGBL 2009 Nr. 41, unter Einbezug der aufgrund des Zollvertrages und der Fremdenpolizeilichen Vereinbarungen anwendbaren schweizerischen Rechtsvorschriften und in Ausführung der Resolutionen 1737 (2006) vom 23. Dezember 2006, 1747 (2007) vom 24. März 2007, 1803 (2008) vom 3. März 2008 und 1929 (2010) vom 9. Juni 2010 des Sicherheitsrates der Vereinten Nationen verordnet die Regierung:
