Universal Periodic Review of South Africa

Intervention by the delegation of Liechtenstein

Liechtenstein welcomes the distinguished delegation of South Africa and wishes to thank for the valuable information provided in the introductory statement and in the national report.

Liechtenstein welcomes South Africa's decision to remain a State Party to the Rome Statute of the ICC. Liechtenstein recommends that South Africa ratify the Kampala amendments to the Rome Statute on the crime of aggression.

Liechtenstein recommends that South Africa review and amend all legislation and regulations relevant to birth registration and nationality to ensure their full conformity with the Convention on the Rights of the Child.

Liechtenstein recommends that South Africa expedite the adoption of legislation to prohibit all forms of corporal punishment in the home, including "reasonable chastisement" and ensure that those who perpetrate corporal punishment are held accountable.

Liechtenstein recommends that all communications surveillance requires a test of necessity and proportionality. Liechtenstein also recommends that South Africa take the necessary steps to ensure that all operations of intelligence agencies are monitored by an independent oversight mechanism.
