



Return journey from risk countries

Quarantine obligation for travellers from areas with increased risk of infection

Liechtenstein has adapted the travel requirements to the current epidemiological situation. As of Monday, 6 July, all persons entering from certain risk areas must be in quarantine for 10 days.

Entry from a state or an area with an increased risk of infection must be reported to the Office of Public Health within 2 days of entry. You will find the appropriate form below. Families and groups must make a declaration for each person.
