

Family reunification

- Legal basis:** Art. 4, para. 1, subsections d and g, as well as Articles 40 through 45 of the Free Movement of Persons Act (PFZG, LGBl. 2009 No. 348) apply to **EEA and Swiss nationals**
- Geltungsbereich:** **EEA and Swiss nationals** with an L, B, C, or D permit may bring their family members to join them at any time. This includes:
- the spouse or registered partner
 - Relatives of the holder of the residence permit and his or her spouse or registered partner in the direct line of descent (including children who are under guardianship, are under 21 years of age, or for whom it can be proven that they are receiving financial support)
 - Relatives of the holder of a residence permit and his or her spouse or registered partner in the direct ascending line who can provide evidence that they are being supported financially
 - Other eligible persons under Art. 4, para. 1, letter g of the PFZG may only be brought to Switzerland by EEA nationals who hold a residence permit (C) or a permanent residence permit (D)
- Deadlines:** The application must be submitted to the Migration and Passports Office, complete and accurate, at least four weeks before the planned date of taking up residence in Liechtenstein.
- Financial means:** For individuals who have been granted a residence permit to take up residence as unemployed persons, as well as for non-EEA and non-Swiss nationals, their financial circumstances are reviewed in addition to their housing situation.

Documents generally required for EEA and Swiss nationals:

- ☐ Application form
- ☐ Form "Personal Information for the Issuance of a Residence Permit" (ger. „Persönliche Angaben zur Ausstellung des Aufenthaltstitels“) including a passport photo and signature
- ☐ A copy of a valid passport or valid ID card (EEA or Swiss nationals)

Additionally, for spouses or registered partners:

- ☐ Original marriage or civil partnership certificate
(If the marriage or registered partnership took place in Vaduz, a copy is sufficient)

Additionally, for one or more children:

- ☐ Original birth certificate(s)
- ☐ Original proof of custody for non-joint children;
Additionally, in cases of joint custody: a notarized statement confirming that the other parent consents to the move to Liechtenstein
- ☐ Child support guarantee for non-joint children
- ☐ Original court order regarding a child in foster care (translated into German by a translation agency recognized in Liechtenstein)
- ☐ Original court order for an adopted child (translated into German by a translation agency recognized in Liechtenstein)

Additionally, for the parents:

- ☐ Written justification
- ☐ Proof of family relationship (e.g., birth certificate, family register, etc.)
- ☐ Proof of financial support

Additionally, for other eligible individuals:

- ☐ Written justification
- ☐ an official certificate confirming the family relationship
- ☐ A guarantee from a bank based in an EEA country, up to a maximum of CHF 156,000 (per person)
- ☐ If financial support is paid:
 - ☐ A confirmation from the competent authority of the country of origin or provenance stating that the further eligible person received support from an EEA national with a residence or permanent residence permit in Liechtenstein for at least 2 years immediately prior to the submission of the application (translated into German by a translation agency recognized in Liechtenstein).
- ☐ In case of serious medical reasons:
 - ☐ A medical certificate stating that there are serious medical reasons that make it absolutely necessary for the EEA national with residence or permanent residence status in Liechtenstein to personally care for the other beneficiary (translated into German by a translation agency recognized in Liechtenstein)
 - ☐ Form „Declaration of Assumption of Responsibility for Personal Care“ (ger. „Erklärung für Übernahme der persönlichen Pflege“)
