

Re-issuing permanent residence (D) and establishment permits (C)

Legal basis:	Art. 26 and 28 of the Act on the Free Movement of Person (PFZG, LGBl. 2009 No. 348) apply to EEA and Swiss nationals Art. 27 of the Act of Foreign Nationals (AuG, LGBl. 2008 No. 311) applies to non-EEA and non-Swiss nationals
Scope of application:	Individuals who have held a C or D permit for at least 10 years and have not been abroad for more than three years (for a D permit) and five years (for a C permit).
Terms:	The application must be submitted completely and correctly to the Migration and Passport Office (APA) four weeks before the planned date of taking up residence in Liechtenstein.

Generally required documents:

- ☐ Written justification issued by the person responsible for human resources
- ☐ Application form
- ☐ Form "Personal Information for the Issuance of a Residence Permit" (ger. „Persönliche Angaben zur Ausstellung des Aufenthaltstitels") including a passport photo and signature
- ☐ A copy of a valid passport or valid ID card (EEA or Swiss nationals)
- ☐ A copy of the employment contract
- ☐ Written justification, including proof of a close relationship with Liechtenstein

Additionally, for non-EEA and non-Swiss nationals:

- ☐ Copy of a valid residence permit if residing in the EEA or Switzerland
- ☐ Original criminal record extract (no older than one month and translated into German by a translation agency recognized in Liechtenstein)
- ☐ Language Proficiency Certificate (German), Level A2
- ☐ Proof of having passed the civics exam
